
FIRST AID TRAUMA CHECKLIST





FIRST AID KIT CHECKLIST

MEDICATIONS



- Pain reliever for headaches, muscle pain, joint pain, and minor injuries.
- Acetaminophen 325 mg
 Relieves mild to moderate pain and reduces fever.
- Aspirin 325 mg
 Pain reliever, anti-inflammatory, and blood thinner.
- Loperamide HCI 2 mg
 Controls diarrhea, useful for travel and emergencies.

- Diphenhydramine 25 mg Allergy relief, hay fever, cold symptoms, and sleep aid.
- Calcium Carbonate 420 mg Neutralizes stomach acid, relieving heartburn and indigestion.
- Narcan (Naloxone)
 Emergency opioid overdose reversal medication; can restore breathing in someone experiencing an opioid overdose.

TOPICAL OINTMENTS



- Povidone lodine Prep Pads
 Antiseptic for disinfecting minor cuts, scrapes, and burns.
- Triple Antibiotic Ointment
 Prevents bacterial infections in minor wounds.
- Hydrocortisone Cream
 Reduces itching, redness, and swelling from skin irritations.
- Alcohol Prep Pads
 Cleans skin before injections or minor procedures.

TOPICAL OINTMENTS



- Benzalkonium Chloride Towelettes Disinfects minor wounds, preventing infection.
- Antimicrobial Alcohol Gel Wipes Sanitizes hands or cleans skin surfaces to kill germs.
- Sting Relief Pads
 Provides quick relief from pain and itching due to insect stings.
- Burn Gel Dressing
 Treats minor burns, providing cooling and protection.

BANDAGES



- Standard Bandages (70)
- Medium Bandages (18)
- Finger Tip Bandages (4)

- Knuckle Bandages (4)
- XL Bandages (4)

ADDITIONAL ESSENTIALS



- Storage Tins / Organizers
 Keeps supplies accessible and well-organized.
- Small Scissors & Tweezers
 For minor cuts, splinters, or bandage adjustments.
- Eyeglass Repair KitHandy for unexpected repairs.
- Travel-Sized Duct Tape
 & Medical Tape
 Quick fixes for gear and wound care.

- Electrolyte Powder
 Helps with hydration, especially during long flights or illness.
- Tampons, Pads, Wipes, Tissues
 Essential for female hygiene
 needs.
- Water Purification Tablets
 A must for overseas travel or emergencies.
- Personal Medications
 Ensure you have prescriptions
 that may be hard to find abroad.

TRAUMA EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

BLEEDING CONTROL



- Nitrile Gloves (Blue, Never Black)
 Protects against contamination
 and cross-infection.
- Hemostatic Gauze Promotes rapid clotting for severe bleeding.
- Used for wound packing and applying direct pressure.

- Mini Compression Bandage Provides direct pressure to wounds in a compact design.
- Israeli Bandage Multi-functional trauma dressing with a built-in pressure bar for severe bleeding control.
- Essential for stopping lifethreatening arterial bleeding on extremities.

AIRWAY & BREATHING



- Nasopharyngeal Airway (NPA)
 Helps maintain an open airway in unconscious individuals.
- Vented Chest Seal Pair
 Seals penetrating chest wounds to prevent tension pneumothorax.

TRAUMA & WOUND CARE



- Mylar Blanket Prevents shock and hypothermia in trauma victims.
- Trauma Shears
 Cuts through
 clothing, seatbelts,
 and bandages
 quickly and safely.
- Used for pupil assessment and examining wounds in low-light conditions.

ADDITIONAL ESSENTIALS



Marker (Permanent or Medical Sharpie)

For marking tourniquet application time.

Elastic Bandage (ACE Wrap)

Provides additional support for sprains, splinting, or securing gauze.

Burn Dressing (Water-Jel or BurnTec)

Treats burns and thermal injuries.

Duct Tape or Medical Tape

Secures bandages, splints, or makes quick repairs.

Triangle Bandage (Cravat)

Can be used for slings, splints, or wound dressing.

SAM Splint

Provides support for fractures and immobilization.

CPR Face Shield or Mask

Ensures safe mouth-to-mouth resuscitation.

Glow Stick or Small LED Light

Helps in low-light conditions or as an emergency signal.

Saline or Wound Irrigation Solution

Cleans wounds before dressing.

LifeVac

A portable airway clearance device designed to remove airway obstructions in choking emergencies.
